## Village of Castleton on Hudson Recycling tips

- Please rinse all recycling containers such as milk cartons, cat food cans, laundry soap containers, etc.
- Please separate recycling inside the containers.
- Please separate plastics, glass jars, metals in one bag or container.
- Please separate newspaper, junk mail, boxboard and other papers in another bag or container.
- Please do not put broken glass as in window panes, dishes, cups in recycling bins. These should be placed in the waste container.
- Please bundle all corrugated cardboard in 3x3 squares or flatten and place on top of container.
- Please do not put pizza boxes in the recycling bin. They should be placed into the waste container.
- Please rinse out your curbside recycling container when possible.
