- Transportation contract and scheduling for roll offs containing MSW, recyclables and C&D from community transfer stations to disposal sites/markets, including special needs and follow up issues
- Development and production of educational materials
- Outreach and positive publicity through local outlets
- Community clean up days for bulky items, scrap metals, tires, etc.
- Assistance with local waste/recycling collection bids and contracts
- Reduction/Reuse/Recycling events and research
- Technical assistance to residents, business or government leaders regarding waste and recycling issues
- Economical, permitted sludge management (if requested)
- Legislative updates regarding solid waste and other environmental issues
- Tracking and reporting of waste generation and recycling rates; solid waste management costs and trends
