SCHAGHTICOKE CLEAN-UP DAYS 2026

2nd Saturday of Every Month
from April thru November

Clean Up Days are designed to manage bulky discards that aren't collected curbside. ERCSWMA arranges for transportation, marketing and disposal of the materials brought in to the Clean Up. A nominal fee (depending on the item being disposed) will be charged to cover the associated costs. These "user fees" (so named because those using the service pay for it) are summarized below. There will be a 5\$ charge per vehicle to help offset the expenses of this service. Payment may be made with cash or a check payable to the Town of Schaghticoke.
